

The doctors at Rose Optical recommend that you have a high-resolution photograph taken of the inside of your eyes as part of a routine eye examination. This photograph is very helpful to the doctors in diagnosing eye diseases, such as glaucoma, macular degeneration, diabetic retinal disease, tumors, and many others. The picture takes only a minute or two to take, and does not affect your vision and normally does not require dilating eye drops. The doctor will show you the photographs and explain them to you today. Your major medical insurance may cover the fee \$70.00 for this procedure if a problem is detected. If not, you will be charged a reduced fee of \$26.00 for the procedure. Payment is due at time of service if you are not using insurance. May we take photographs of your eyes today?
